## BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR REVIEWERS

1. Expertise in subject(s) covered by one or more topic areas
2. Previous experience reviewing proposals for related conferences or publications
3. Commitment to complete review of the assigned proposals according to the deadlines
4. Agree not to distribute manuscripts under review or to disclose information within the manuscript.

## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The conference applies the double-blind peer review process. The submission system used for submissions, reviewing and communication is EasyChair.

## TIMELINES

The reviews are going to be conducted in three phases:

- Review period for abstracts of academic papers: May 15th to June 15th
- Review period for other format submissions (workshops, posters, slide decks, format Xs and): June 15th to July 15th
- Review period for full-length submissions (academic papers and short papers): July 15th to August 8th
