National Institute of Fashion Technology announces the 'Call for Entries' for International Student Design Competition 2025.

THE TRACK

The theme of the competition 'Sustainable Future: Innovation with Indigenous Knowledge' aims to engage young minds to explore, experiment and apply the principles of sustainable design, drawing inspiration from indigenous elements including materials, techniques and cultures. In alignment with the United Nations Sustainable Design Goals, the competition encourages innovation that revives traditional wisdom for a greener future. The award winning entries shall be in a static showcase during Bharat Tex 2025 organized by the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India, from 14th to 17th February 2025 at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi, India.

NATURE OF SUBMISSION:

Design submissions will be in the form of any one of the following:

- Moving Images
- Installations and Mixed-Media Displays
- Textile Art
- Apparel Art
- Lifestyle Product Innovation

Submission of entries (Phase I) – 4th December 2024 Declaration of shortlisted participants – 18th December 2024 Final Submission of entries (Phase-II)– 17th January 2025 Announcement of results - 28th January 2025

WHO CAN APPLY:

Undergraduate and postgraduate design students from universities and design schools in India and abroad.

HOW TO APPLY:

Phase I – Participation entries

The entry in pdf format should include

- Concept note (200 words approx.)
- Concept drawings including dimensions, materials, and other details
- Supporting details (Swatches, trims etc., if any)
- Copy of student ID card

Phase II - Shortlisted entries

- Visuals of actualized design (In accordance with Phase I entry)
- High-resolution images (JPEG format, resolution 300dpi, individual file size should not exceed 5MB)

- Assign a title for each image with your name and photo number, for example: Name-1.jpg, Name-2.jpg, Name-3.jpg, Name-4.jpg).
- Ensure that the images represent the design work clearly. Inadequate images will be rejected.

All entries (Phase I & Phase II) must be submitted via email: designcomp.bt2025@nift.ac.in

JURY & EVALUATION PROCESS:

Phase I: The jury panel shall comprise academicians from National Institute of Fashion Technology

Phase II: The jury panel shall comprise eminent members of Indian fashion industry; fashion design and research experts; members of the academia.

The evaluation of submitted material (visuals of actualized design, in accordance with Phase I entry) will be based on the following criteria:

- Design innovation
- Relevance to the theme
- Originality
- Clarity in verbal & visual communication

In all matters concerning the course of the competition, including the selection of award winners and settlement of disputes, the decision of the jury will be final.

AWARDS:

The top 10 entries will be displayed at Bharat Tex 2025.

- First Prize: INR 3,00,000
- Second Prize: INR 1,50,000
- Third Prize: INR 75,000

PARTICIPATION FEES:

There is no participation fee.

NATURE OF ENTRY:

Contestants may participate individually or as a team of 2-4 students.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

All contestants should adhere to the announced deadlines and Terms & Conditions, failing which the entry will be automatically disqualified.

- The chosen contestants will bring their actualized design entry for the final showcase at New Delhi.
